Spring Green Salad Table Topper

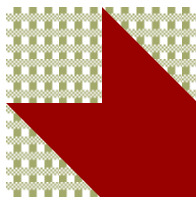
Finished Size: 29" square
 Finished Block Size = 8"
 Unfinished Block Size = 8 1/2"

All Seams 1/4"
 Press Toward the Darkest Fabrics

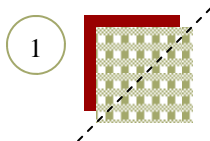


Fabric Requirements	Fabric Amount
Rust	3/4 yard (includes binding)
Beige (Gingham in photograph)	3/8 yard
Patterned (greens & rusts in photograph)	3/8 yard
Sage Green	3/8 yard (borders)

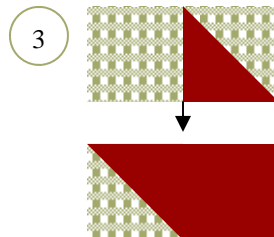
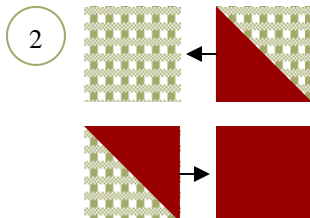
These fabric requirements are for the entire table runner top and binding. You will need additional fabric for the backing.



Fabrics	Cuts (for 1 block, you need 4 blocks)
Rust & Beige	Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" square of EACH fabric
Rust & Beige	Cut ONE (1) 4 7/8" square of EACH fabric



1 Draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the backs of the BEIGE squares. Put the RUST and BEIGE squares together and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles. Press toward the darkest fabric.



This is for ONE block, you need FOUR of these blocks to make quilted this table topper.

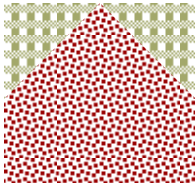

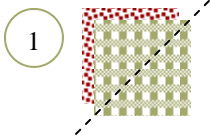
Spring Green Salad Table Topper

Finished Size: 29" square
 Finished Block Size = 8"
 Unfinished Block Size = 8 1/2"

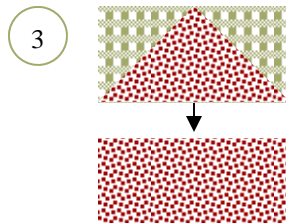
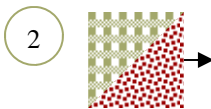
All Seams 1/4"
 Press Toward the Darkest Fabrics



Fabrics	Cuts (for 1 block, you need 4 blocks)
Patterned	Cut ONE (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" strip
Patterned & Beige	Cut ONE (1) 4 7/8" square of EACH fabric



1 Draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, on the backs of the BEIGE squares. Put the PATTERNED and BEIGE squares together and sew 1/4" on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Then, cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew. You will end up with TWO (2) half-square. Press toward the darkest fabric.



This is for ONE block, you need FOUR of these blocks to make quilted this table topper.



Fabrics	Cuts (for 1 block, you need 4 blocks)
Rust	Cut ONE (1) 8 1/2" square

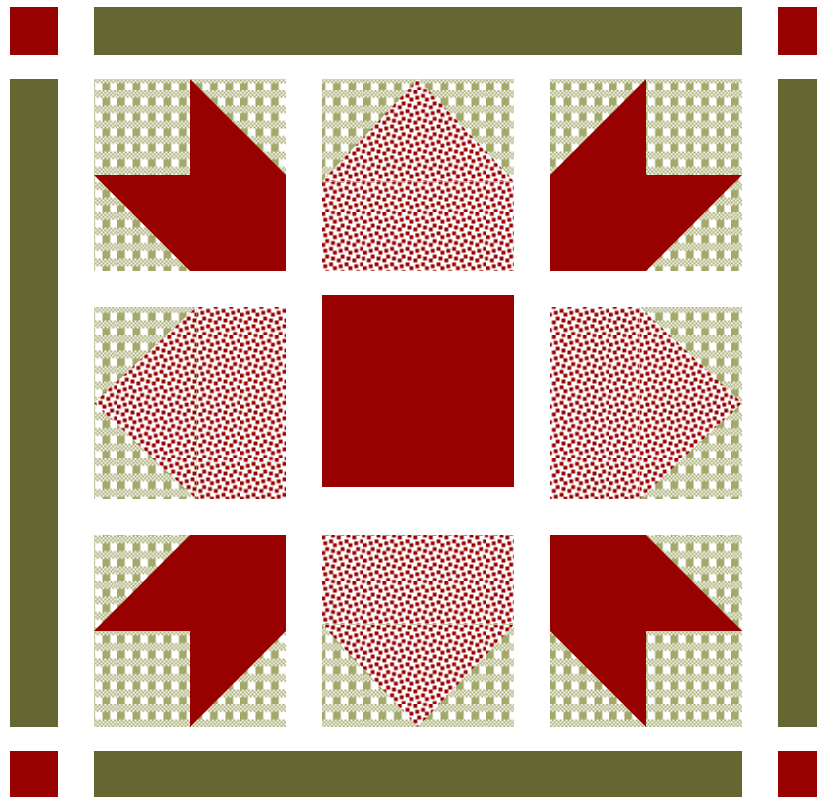
Finished Size: 29" square
 Finished Block Size = 8"
 Unfinished Block Size = 8 1/2"

All Seams 1/4"
 Press Toward the Darkest Fab-
 rics



Fabrics	Cuts
Sage Green	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" strips
Rust	Cut FOUR (4) 2 1/2" squares
Rust	Cut enough 2 1/2" x WOF strips to piece together for the binding

Finishing Instructions - sew your Nine blocks together, then add your borders and corners.

 add your binding!**
